

## Form for accessing data from the EuroTMJ database (eurotmj.org) 2020-2022

The items mentioned below must be presented in a maximum of 8 pages (letter size minimum 11, typed 1.5 spaces).

1. Project title (up to 30 words)
2. Abstract (up to 350 words)
3. Introduction
a) framework (brief review of current knowledge)
b) preliminary data (if any)
c) hypothesis to test
d) potential study interest (scientific relevance) and originality
4. Specific objectives of the study
5. Methodology to be applied
a) type of study (transversal, longitudinal)
b) description of the independent variables and how they will be measured
c) potential confounding bias and how they will be assessed
d) outcomes and their evaluation

- e) statistical analysis that should include a summary description of the methodology to be carried out according to the characteristics of the outcome (s)
- 6. Simple description of the expected results and limitations of the study
- 7. Scheduling of tasks, including start and end date scheduled for data collection, period of time on which the assessment falls data, expected date for data analysis, reporting and publication
- 8. Ethical considerations
- 9. Identification of the applicant, the work team and the Institutions where the investigation will be carried out, with an indication of the relevant to the job and a brief description of the tasks to be play for each one. It is important to prove that the team dominates the clinical epidemiology techniques relevant to this type of job.
